COMMON PROBLEMS/DISEASES

- Heart disease in women
- Ischemia with no obstructive coronary artery disease (INOCA)
- Coronary microvascular dysfunction
- Coronary vasospasm
- Myocardial infarction with no obstructive coronary artery disease (MINOCA)
- Takotsubo cardiomyopathy
- Heart failure with preserved ejection fraction (HFpEF)
- Spontaneous coronary artery dissection
- Cardio-oncology
- Familial dyslipidemias
- Novel CVD risk factors (adverse pregnancy outcomes, including preeclampsia, hypertension in pregnancy, preterm delivery, small for gestational age, gestational diabetes, autoimmune diseases, polycystic ovary syndrome)
