### EXCEPTIONAL NEUROINTENSIVIST AND NEUROVASCULAR OPPORTUNITIES

We are currently seeking nationally recognized leaders in Vascular Neurology and Neurological Intensive Care. The successful candidates will join an exceptional peer group and contribute to enhancing a nationally recognized clinical and academic department. Cedars-Sinai is a Primary Stroke Center, has achieved GWTG Gold Plus recognition for three years and is expanding a 12-bed 'closed model' ICU.

**Neurointensivist;** Junior and senior level faculty members who will help lead and enhance a multidisciplinary critical care team including neurosurgeons, neurologists, trauma surgeons, residents, fellows and nurse practitioners. Two faculty will be recruited. The ideal candidates should have completed an ACGME approved residency program in neurology as well as an approved fellowship in neuro critical care medicine and be board certified or eligible in Neuro Critical Care. In addition, the senior level candidate should have 5-7 years post training and have a demonstrated track record of leadership in both research and clinical service. The candidate should feel comfortable working in a "closed" Neuro ICU model, and should have exceptionally strong ICU procedural skills.

**Vascular Neurologist;** A Vascular Neurologist to join our internationally recognized stroke team. The candidate should have completed an ACGME approved residency program in neurology as well as an approved fellowship in Vascular Neurology and be board certified or eligible in Vascular Neurology. Expertise in transcranial ultrasound is especially encouraged.

Candidates must be California licensed or license eligible, and qualified for appointment at the appropriate academic rank. Each candidate should have an established track record in both clinical and investigative neurology, and have an established or exceptional potential for a clinical academic career.

Academic appointment through the Cedars-Sinai professorial series and the David Geffen School of Medicine at the University of California Los Angeles or equivalent is essential.
