4. Strong analytical, quantitative and problem solving skills
5. Expert knowledge of U.S. health care organizations, policy, practice and management, especially related to teaching hospitals.
6. Advanced computer skills including excellent knowledge of computer applications to perform statistical analysis, database management, spreadsheet analysis, word processing and presentations
