Cedars Sinai Medical Center is seeking a Transplant Surgeon at the Assistant or Associate Professor level to join the Department of Surgery and the Comprehensive Transplant Center. Candidates must be ABS board certified or eligible in General Surgery and have completed an ASTS-approved two-year multi-organ transplantation fellowship. This is an academic multi-organ transplant surgery position that includes teaching and research responsibilities. Cedars-Sinai maintains a vigorous ASTS-approved (liver & kidney) transplant fellowship and the full-time transplant faculty are dedicated to mentoring the next generation of transplant surgeons.

Current clinical volumes at Cedars-Sinai include more than 200 abdominal organ transplants and more than 100 thoracic transplants annually. Candidates for the transplant surgery faculty position should have experience in liver, kidney and pancreas transplantation, as well as multi-organ procurement. Interest and experience in complex hepatobiliary procedures is preferred. Cedars-Sinai currently maintains a volume of approximately 450 major hepatobiliary surgeries each year.
