We'll ensure that your complaint is handled expeditiously and is thoroughly investigated. If your complaint was not anonymous, we'll follow up with you. Cedars-Sinai prohibits retaliation against any person who makes a complaint of discrimination, harassment or inappropriate conduct, or who assists or participates in any manner in an investigation or resolution of such a complaint.
