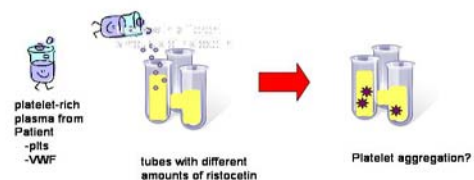
Integrated and consultative services for the evaluation of patients with inherited and acquired bleeding disorders, thromboembolic complications and acquired thrombophilia are provided utilizing the following coagulation panels

- Von Willebrand disease screening
- Thrombophilia, basic
- Thrombophilia for patients on anticoagulants
- Heparin Induced Thrombocytopenia (HIT)
- Thrombotic Thrombocytopenic purpura (TTP)
- CVA, TIA and Cerebral Vein Thrombosis
- Abnormal PT and/or PTT evaluation
- Platelet Function Assay (PFA-100)
- Obstetrics profile for repeated fetal loss or Pre-eclampsia
- Liver disease profile
- DIC profile
- Dysfibrinogenemia evaluation
- Platelet Aggregometry for bleeding disorders, Hypercoagulability, and Myeloproliferative Disorders
- Aspirin and Plavix resistance
- Anti-Phospholipid Antibody evaluation
