

Call for Applications: Awards for Research in Women's Health and Sex Differences



The Center for Research in Women's Health Science (CREWHS) is calling for investigators to submit their research on women's health or sex differences. The work can be basic science, translational or clinical in nature, and ideally will establish collaboration between clinical and basic science investigators or between junior and senior investigators.

Winners of the award will receive up to \$50,000 (direct costs) for a year with a potential to extend for a second year.

Applicants should submit their NIH biosketch, a 2-page research description, lay summary (max. 4 sentences) and a detailed budget with justification. The research description should outline the question being addressed, demonstrate feasibility of the proposed research, include a statement on how the work will impact women's health or sex differences in health or disease and what outputs are expected as a result of the award (abstracts, publications, grant submissions). Projects with high translational impact and with a strong potential to reach next-level funding will be prioritized.

Awardees can avail of mentorship from CREWHS steering committee members.
