Description

This elective provides an excellent opportunity to learn about and manage renal disease in patients with frequent multisystem dysfunction. The student is given responsibility under the supervision of faculty, fellows, and residents. The formal teaching sessions include Renal Pathology and Renal Grand Rounds. The fellows will have prepared a discussion of a specific area of renal pathophysiology or renal physiology, before which all students are urged to have read some of the patient material.

Course Objectives

- Perform a proper history and physical examination for the nephrology patient.
- Acquire knowledge in the differential diagnosis and management of fluid, electrolyte, and acid-base problems.
- Acquire knowledge of the clinical strategy in evaluation of the patient with renal disease.
- Develop a practical approach to diagnosis and medical management of hypertension.
- Review and update basic knowledge of renal physiology.
- Exposure to clinical problems of uremia, dialysis, renal transplantation, and renal immunopathology.
