Description

Designed for students with an interest in Hematology. Students will work-up and manage 4-8 patients per week with various benign and malignant hematology diagnoses. Typical patients include those with bleeding or thrombotic problems, hypercoagulable states, unexplained cytopenias, myeloproliverative disorders, hemolytic anemias, complications of blood transfusions, histiocytic disorders, or need for apheresis procedures. Students will be involved in the continuous care of these patients for the duration consultative hematology is required. Students will review patient data, including laboratory data, bone marrow biopsies and radiographs. Students will also become knowledgeable in the diagnostic workup and management of disorders of coagulation and cytopenias.

Course Objectives

- Learn how to evaluate patients with benign and malignant heme diagnoses. Diagnosis and treatment of a variety of solid tumors.
- Management of hematologic disorders.
- Management of therapy-related complications.
- Evaluation and management of internal medicine problems in cancer patients.
- Management of psychological aspects of neoplastic disorders.
- · Management of terminal illness and palliative care.
