## Description

This is a combined inpatient/ consultative service for Neurology. Students have an opportunity to evaluate and work up a variety of commonly seen neurological conditions including stroke, seizures, altered mental status, multiple sclerosis and movement disorders. The team consists of neurology and medicine residents, 3<sup>rd</sup> year medical students and a full-time faculty member. Sub Interns will be assigned their own patients with close supervision. Students will take part in multiple didactic sessions including weekly lectures, seminars, and grand round presentations. Students will see patients in the outpatient clinic setting one day per week.

## Course Objectives

1. Ability to obtain pertinent history and perform detailed neurological examination to localize abnormalities within the nervous system.
2. Develop comprehensive differential diagnosis and prioritize appropriate workup for patients with neurological disease.
3. Discuss risks and benefits of medications commonly used for neurological disease.
4. Work effectively as part of a healthcare team.
5. Identify and utilize community resources for patients with neurological disorders.
6. Develop and deliver a brief oral presentation to the team
