## Description

The rotations will be split up into two services: Cobalt (Spine and Peds) and Grey (Tumors and Vascular). The student will be responsible for the care of 3-5 neurosurgical patients under direct supervision of the department housestaff and faculty. The student will attend didactic conferences and have the opportunity to present a topic of their choice to the faculty and staff. The student will scrub into the patients' surgeries when appropriate as well as attend specialty outpatient clinics.

- Development of judgment in selection of operative treatments
- Learn risks and complications of neurosurgical procedures
- Gain experience in pre and post-operative management of neurosurgical patients
