Description

Senior medical students will function as junior residents for anatomic and/or clinical pathology. They will be supervised individually by faculty and senior housestaff as they gain anatomic- clinical pathology experience and attend sign out sessions. Rotators will be expected to attend departmental conferences and didactics. As feasible, the rotation experience will be tailored to the students' interests in pathology.
